Acts 8:5 "Philip went down to a city in Samaria and proclaimed Christ there."

Purpose: To show how God's Spirit works in our hearts.

Proposition: God prepares us for what He has prepare for us.

## Introduction:

- 1. Wouldn't you love to have been guided by God?
- 2. Can you imagine leading another person to the Lord?
- 3. Do you dream about God using you in a special way?
- 4. How did God prepare Philip for this special time?
- I. God shaped Philip through his obedience.
  - A. When persecution broke out in Jerusalem, Philip went to another place to tell people about Jesus.
  - B. Prior to this event Philip served widows.
    - 1. He waited tables.
    - 2. He supervised a compassionate care ministry.
- II. God prepared Philip through a revival (6-8).
  - A. Philip told people about Jesus and crowds listened.
  - B. God worked miracles through Philip.
- III. God prepared Philip through Bible study.

  #When the Ethiopian read from Isaiah, Philip knew where
  the passage was, who is was about and how the Ethiopian
  could meet Jesus.

- IV. God prepared Philip by the Holy Spirit's conversation.
  - A. God gave orders to a man who would hear and heed the directions.
  - B. God needed a minister in Ethiopia.
    - 1. God needed to see him get right in his heart first.
    - 2. So God sent Philip.
